ABOUT BOARD ORIENTATION

Holding a Board of Directors Orientation can provide a newly-elected board member with the information necessary to serve his or her community efficiently and effectively.

With respect to legal issues, an effective orientation should be sure to address the following topics:

- The roles of the Board of Directors, committee members, homeowners, management, and vendors.
- The Association's governing documents and how they operate.
- Board meetings and actions (i.e., proper process for holding Board meetings and voting at a meeting or outside of a meeting via email).
- The Board's fiduciary obligations.
- Steps for minimizing liability exposure to the Board and to the Association.

WHAT WE CAN DO TO HELP
