Holding a Covenant Enforcement Orientation can provide a newly-elected board member (or even a seasoned one!) with the information necessary to serve their community efficiently and effectively. With respect to legal issues, an effective orientation should be sure to address the following topics:

- The differences between Covenants and Rules, and the hierarchy of governing documents and law;
- Identifying violations and enforcement options;
- Procedural requirements under the <u>Colorado Common Interest Ownership Act</u>, particularly now that <u>HB22-1137</u> has thrown a wrench in an association's enforcement steps;
- How to properly fine and ensure compliance with the Association's governing documents;
- Alternative Dispute Resolution; and
- The Court process.
